Direct Flight to Israel Coming to the DC-Baltimore Area

United Airlines announced last month that it will be launching non-stop service to Tel Aviv (TLV) from Washington Dulles Airport (IAD). Thanks to everyone in our community who signed the online petition calling for a direct flight from our region, joining our partners at the JCRC of Greater Washington, the Israeli American Council, the Maryland/Israel Development Center, the Virginia Israel Advisory Board, the Maryland-Israel Sister State Committee, and others. United will start flights on the new route May 22 and initially operate it three times a week.

A Successful Summer Teachers Institute Wraps Up

The Israelis, of various backgrounds and age groups, are traveling the country and will participate in 12 other similar events.
