

CAPITAL BUDGET REQUESTS

Renovations and Expansion of The Associated's Park Heights Campus - \$1 Million

The Baltimore Jewish Council and The Associated: Jewish Federation of Baltimore, respectfully request your support in FY 2025 for \$1 million toward The Associated's Park Heights Campus Expansion and Renovation. This project previously received \$1 million in FY23 and \$500,000 in FY24. The Park Heights campus of The Associated has served for generations as a hub for Baltimore's Jewish community and Northwest Baltimore. The Associated intends to significantly expand its presence and investment in the Park Heights campus, as part of a broader plan to move The Associated's central headquarters from its current location on Mt. Royal Avenue up to the Park Heights campus. The full project is approximately \$20 million, with much of the cost raised through private philanthropy.

LEGISLATIVE BOND INITIATIVES

The Gordon Center for Performing Arts - \$300,000 (Baltimore County, District 11B)

Considered the premier performing arts venue in Baltimore County, the Gordon is located on the campus of the Rosenbloom Owings Mills JCC and serves as the centerpiece of the JCC's Center for Arts & Culture, which includes youth arts education and cultural programming for adults. The purpose of this project is to provide environmental and accessibility improvements to the building, including upgrading to LED lighting fixtures and installing a gender-neutral bathroom in the lobby.

The Edward A. Myerberg Center - \$250,000 (Baltimore City, District 41)

Founded in 1976 as the Northwest Senior Center, The Edward A. Myerberg Senior Center is the largest privately-run and operated community center for older adults in Baltimore City. The purpose of this project is to enable the Edward A. Myerberg Senior Center to improve facilities, including a new roof; an overhaul of heating, ventilation and air-conditioning systems throughout the building; asphalt resurfacing and repair; concrete and landscaping repairs; window repair and replacement; and other building systems.
